Warranty Terms and Conditions

Our warranty is designed to ensure that your Urban Sheds structure stands the test of time under normal use. However, the following terms apply:

- 1. Exclusions: This warranty does not cover damage caused by weather events, falling objects (such as trees), natural disasters, improper use, or neglect.
- 2. Alterations: Modifications made by the customer or third parties—including but not limited to ramps, decks, or additions—void this warranty.
- 3.Non-Urban Sheds Components: Components sourced from third parties or installed by non-Urban Sheds builders are not covered under this warranty.
- 4.Normal Wear and Tear: Routine aging, including changes in wood or metal color due to weather or time, is not covered under this warranty. Accessories and cosmetic elements are excluded from coverage.
- 5. Foundation Requirements: Sheds must be installed on a properly prepared foundation such as cement blocks, crushed stone, or a concrete pad. Re-leveling due to settling on unsuitable ground or poor soil conditions is not covered.
- 6. Customer Responsibility: The customer is responsible for maintaining proper drainage around the structure to prevent water damage. Excessive weight on the roof, such as snow or debris accumulation, may void this warranty.
- 7. Relocation and Resale: This warranty is non-transferable. Any resale or relocation of the structure automatically voids all coverage.
